# ALPACA FARM DAY

Aimed at Yr 9-11 students working to match  
Staffordshire term dates.

**payable at the start of each**  
**1/2 term.**

## What's involved?

After 'tea and toast' to start the day at our Burton centre, with time to set individual targets, we will head to a local alpaca farm for the rest of the day.

Once at the farm, we will take part in a CALMs session led by Chris, the owner and breeder at the farm. Cognitive Alpaca Learning Methods harnesses the calming nature of alpacas and also helps students to understand that their hidden fears and aggression can be picked up by these sensitive creatures, which in turn helps them gain a deeper understanding of the impact their emotions can have on others.

There will be some classroom time at the farm where worksheets and photos will be used to record learning. Students will work towards an AIM Awards Level 1 Award in Skills for Employment and Further Learning (Animal Care). Lunch is provided, as is the opportunity to say goodbye to the friendly alpacas before returning to the centre to review targets and finish the day.
