What's involved?

Students will complete a wide variety of community projects throughout the year. These are likely to include tidying up gardens for the elderly, visiting day centres, volunteering in a charity shop, painting and tidying of community spaces, work with the fire brigade and many more. By the end of the year students should have achieved AIM Awards Level 1 Certificate in Skills for Employment & Further Learning (QCF).

The project will run 1 day a week from September. Whilst students are booked on half term at a time, in order to gain the qualification students will need to attend for the majority of the year. It may be possible to gain a lower tariff AIM award if attending for just one term of the year. This course is therefore aimed at being an embedded solution to their whole year of education. **Max group size 6.**

COST: £90 per day per pupil
